

## **Gutter Ball**

### **Overview**

*This teambuilder challenges students work with a partner while working simultaneously together as entire group.*

### **Materials**

- *A set of about 10 gutters equipped with ropes IMAGE*
- *A golf ball*
- *A small bucket, tin or hat*

### **Time**

*20-45 min*

### **Audience**

*Gr. 4-12*

### **Procedure**

*The goal of Gutter Ball is to move a golf ball using only the gutters to a bucket. Sound easy enough? Students will quickly realize that achieving this goal requires focus, communication, teamwork and manual dexterity!*

### *The Rules*

- *You can only move the ball using the gutters*
- *You can only manipulate the gutters with the attached strings*
- *If the ball touches the ground or anything other than the black gutter you need to start over*
- *When the ball is in your gutter you cannot move your feet. When it's not you can move freely*
- *Minimum two people per gutter and a maximum of four*

*Success is getting the ball into the bucket/can without it falling. Get your mind in the gutter!*

## **Risk Management**

- *Using the gutters to fling the golf ball is a dangerous idea and should not be permitted.*
